SunVideo Plus 1.3 Installation

This document describes how to install the SunVideo™ Plus hardware and software. The *SunVideo Plus 1.3 Installation Guide*, provided with this installation kit, is a multilingual document of the instructions described here.

Installation Kit

The SunVideo Plus 1.3 Installation Kit includes:

- SunVideo Plus 1.3 card
- SunVideo Plus 1.3 software (CD)
- Antistatic wriststrap
- *SunVideo Plus 1.3 Installation Guide*

System Requirements

You can install SunVideo Plus software on any SPARC™ system running Solaris™ 2.5.1, Solaris 2.6, or Solaris 7 operating environments.

Installing the SunVideo Plus Card

1. Install the SunVideo Plus card according to the installation procedures for PCI-bus cards provided with your SunTM system.
2. After installing the SunVideo Plus card and securing your system enclosure, boot your system by typing:

```
hostname# reboot -- -r
```

Once installed, the SunVideo Plus 1.3 software resides in `/etc/opt/SUNWolkp`, `/opt/SUNWolkp`, and `/opt/SUNWopi`. The XIL Runtime pipeline software resides in `/usr/openwin`.

Removing Previous Software Releases

You must remove any previous releases of the SunVideo Plus software before installing any new software packages.

- 1. Log in as superuser.**
- 2. Uninstall previous SunVideo Plus software packages.**

Note – SUNWolkpu and SUNWolkpd are core packages; hence, be sure that these packages are removed *last* by the `pkgrm` command (as shown below).

- Remove SunVideo Plus 1.0 by typing:

```
hostname# /usr/sbin/pkgrm SUNWvtsvp SUNWsvpab SUNWolkpu  
SUNWolkpd
```

- Remove SunVideo Plus 1.1 or 1.2 by typing:

```
hostname# /usr/sbin/pkgrm SUNWvtsvp SUNWsvpab SUNWolkpx  
SUNWolkpu SUNWolkpd
```

Installing the SunVideo Plus 1.3 Software

The SunVideo Plus 1.3 software is provided on the CD included with your SunVideo Plus installation kit.

1. **Log in as superuser (root).**
2. **Insert the SunVideo Plus 1.3 CD into the CD-ROM drive connected to your system.**

- If your system is running Volume Manager, it should automatically mount the CD-ROM to the `/cdrom/sunvideo_plus_1_3` directory.
- If your system is not running Volume Manager, mount the CD-ROM as follows:

```
hostname# mkdir -p /cdrom/sunvideo_plus_1_3
hostname# mount -F hsfs -r /dev/dsk/c0t6d0s2
/cdrom/sunvideo_plus_1_3
```

3. Install the SunVideo Plus 1.3 software using the `pkgadd` command:

- a. Install the base software packages for the Solaris 2.5.1, Solaris 2.6, and Solaris 7 operating environments:

```
hostname# cd /cdrom/sunvideo_plus_1_3/Common/Packages
hostname# /usr/sbin/pkgadd -d .
```

Choose `all` to install the base packages.

- b. Proceed to install specific Solaris release software packages.

- To install the Solaris 2.5.1 Hardware: 4/97, 8/97, and 11/97 operating environment, type:

```
hostname# cd /cdrom/sunvideo_plus_1_3/Solaris_2.5.1/  
Packages  
hostname# /usr/sbin/pkgadd -d .
```

Choose all.

- To install the Solaris 2.6 operating environment, type:

```
hostname# cd /cdrom/sunvideo_plus_1_3/Solaris_2.6/  
Packages  
hostname# /usr/sbin/pkgadd -d .
```

Choose all.

- To install the Solaris 7 operating environment, type:

```
hostname# cd /cdrom/sunvideo_plus_1_3/Solaris_7/  
Packages  
hostname# /usr/sbin/pkgadd -d .
```

Choose all.

4. After the software has been installed, unmount and eject the CD-ROM:

```
hostname# cd /  
hostname# umount /cdrom/sunvideo_plus_1_3  
hostname# eject cdrom
```

5. Reboot your workstation:

```
hostname# reboot -- -r
```

This enables the operating system to recognize the SunVideo Plus card.
