## Read the Release Notes

## Have the Installation Site Ready

Refer to the *Sun StorEdge T3 Disk Tray Site Preparation and Planning Guide* and the *Sun StorEdge T3 Disk Tray Configuration Guide*, available from your Sun representative. Before the installation:

- Have the required hardware and software for your specific configuration available.
- Install the host adapter(s) in the host system. Refer to the documentation that is packaged with the host adapter for installation instructions.
- If you are connecting the disk tray(s) to a hub(s), prepare and cable the hub configuration.



## Install the Required Patches on the Host System
