- Purchase the Sun StorEdge Array System Installation Service. This service is sold separately and provides complete system installation of your Sun StorEdge 6320 system and includes activation of Sun StorEdge Remote Response service.
- Purchase the Sun StorEdge Remote Response Installation Service. This service is sold separately and provides installation and configuration of Sun StorEdge Remote Response hardware and includes activation of Sun StorEdge Remote Response service.

Sun StorEdge Remote Response Eligibility

Customers must maintain the entire Sun StorEdge 6320 system on warranty or SunSpectrum Gold, SunSpectrum Gold with 7x24 uplift, or SunSpectrum Platinum service contract in order to receive the Sun StorEdge Remote Response service.
